



Thread drawn around the edge of material. Stitch/Seam type 502EFd-1	Seam width 8 - 10mm
81200AC Single needle, three thread carpet overedging machine, Top and bottom feed, with Tape Binding Stitch length 4 to 9SPI (6 - 2.5mm) Sewing capacity up to 1/2" (12mm)	For decorative overseaming on carpets and rugs with rubber backing or rubber foam backing. With top and bottom feed, material is fed uniformly, without stitch shortening or perforating backing. The binding tape is put around the carpet edge by a tape binder folder and covered by the overedge seam. 81200CZ124 Single needle, three thread carpet overedging machine, Plain feed Stitch length 8 to 16SPI (3.2 -1.6mm) Sewing capacity up to 1/2" (12mm)	For decorative overseaming on carpets and mats with inside and outside curves. Thread drawn to the edge of material. Stitch/Seam type 505EFd-1	Seam width 8 - 10mm
